

Apex Chamber and Town Staff to Present Business Workshop

The Apex Chamber of Commerce is partnering with the Town of Apex to present a free workshop on starting and owning a business in Apex. The two-hour session will be presented at the Halle Cultural Arts Center in downtown Apex. It will feature an opening general session followed by a series of breakout sessions for specific questions and issues. The session will be free and breakfast will be served.

All those interested in learning more about operating a business in Apex are invited to attend. The workshop will be held Wednesday, September 18th from 8-10 am.
