Our program provides door-to-door, shared-ride service. We provide transportation to those who:

- Are age 60 or older,
- Have a disability,
- Need work-related transportation, or
- Reside in rural service zones of Wake County.



WHERE DO WE SERVE?

We provide elderly, disabled and employment trips to and from all areas of the county. Rural transportation services are offered by zone:

NORTHERN	Areas surrounding Wake Forest and Rolesville
EASTERN	Areas surrounding Knightdale, Wendell and Zebulon
SOUTHERN	Areas surrounding Garner
SOUTHWEST	Areas surrounding Fuquay-Varina, Holly Springs, Apex and Morrisville

HOW DO I GET A RIDE?

Service is available by reservation on a first-come, seat-available basis.

Must be made 24 hours in advance.

Cancellation: (919) 996-4444

Must be made at least one hour prior to your scheduled pick-up time.

Monday through Saturday

6 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(excluding holidays).

There is a nominal charge per person, per trip for TRACS services.
