**ADDITION/ALTERATION/ACCESSORY
STRUCTURE SUBMITTAL CHECKLIST
(Decks, screen porches, attics and
basements have separate checklists)**

ALL permit submittals must include:

- Plan Check fee of \$100
- One & Two Family Application (signed in ink)
- 1 Copy of Building Plan
- 1 Plot Plan (81/2" x 11" or 81/2" x 14") showing location of addition/accessory structure and impervious surface SF. If on well/septic Wake Co. approval is required.
- Homeowner-Exemption-Questionnaire (projects over \$30,000)
- 1 Copy of Workers Compensation Compliance Verification (over \$30,000)
- Certificate of Liability Insurance showing Workers Comp Coverage (over \$30,000)
- If work is NOT being done to primary residence provide 2 Copies NC Lien Agent Designation Forms (over \$30,000)

INSTRUCTIONS

Checking a box indicates that this item has been provided in the manner requested. A re-review fee may be assessed to incomplete or incorrectly prepared application packages.

PLOT PLAN (REQUIRED)

Plot Plan Provided: The plot plan must be drawn in ink showing the entire lot with the outline of the buildings(s), decks, porches, driveways, mechanical equipment, easements, buffers, and setbacks. Dimensions must be provided for all building and structures and the dimensions must be consistent with the plans provided for review. Indicate the distance from each property line to the structure at the nearest point. All plot plans must be to a designated scale (preferable 1":20'). Impervious surface (SF) must also be provided.

If on well/septic: Wake county approval is needed. Please go to <http://www.wakegov.com/water/wastewater/Pages/default.aspx> to apply for the approval. You will be applying for an Accessory Structure permit. Once approved you will need to provide us with the plot plan that has the Wake County approval stamp.
