## **2021 CAMP PROTOCOLS**

With the return of in-person camps, we want to share some details regarding what the procedures will look like. *During your camp week, please check your email often as that is how we will communicate important information to you.*

### **Guidelines**

- If students are feeling unwell or exhibit any COVID-19 symptoms, please keep them home. *You can email [halleculturalartscenter@apexnc.org](mailto:halleculturalartscenter@apexnc.org) to let us know if a student will be missing class.*
- Education staff will greet you in the parking lot at the top of the stairs to the shelter.
- Masks that cover the nose and mouth are required, except when eating or drinking.
- Please provide your child with water and a snack each day (peanut-free), and make sure they are lathered with sunscreen. Water fountains have been disabled out at the parks.

### **Weather**

- Each evening before camp, the instructors will check the weather forecast. If there is a 60% or greater chance of rain for the next morning, camp that day will be held at The Halle Cultural Arts Center [237 N. Salem Street]. All parents will receive an email by 7:15pm the night prior, if the camp location has been changed.
- If it lightly rains while we are in camp, there are covered areas we can retreat to and continue the camp day.
- If there is a downpour or lightning and thunder, we will go inside the restrooms for protection. All parents will then receive an email asking them to pick up their child and bring them to The Halle Cultural Arts Center to finish the camp day *if time permits.*
